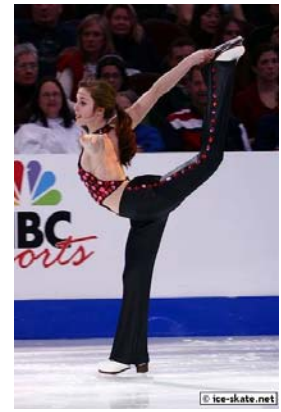
Announcing the 2011 Hickory Hill Figure Skating Club Annual Meeting!

Refreshments will also be served, so please RSVP as soon as possible to Club Secretary Amy at aehodman@aol.com.

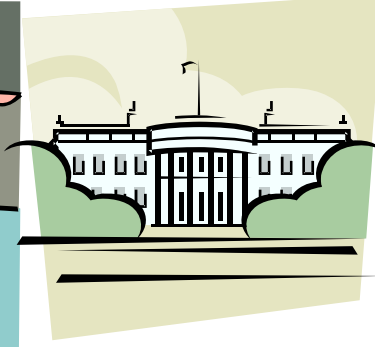
Skate-To-Learn

Skate-to-Learn is an exciting figure skating show at the [Ice House in Hackensack, NJ](#) featuring 3-Time US National Champion and 2-Time Olympian **Johnny Weir**, US National Silver Medalist **Brandon Mroz**, 2-Time US National Bronze Medalist **Ashley Wagner** and US National Pewter medalist **Agnes Zawadzki**. The show, which is being produced by high school students and figure skaters David Cruikshank, Christine Mozer and Courtney Taylor, will take place on [Sunday May 1 at 3:00pm](#), and will benefit two charities providing after-school programs for children--Brooklyn Ice (which gives free skating lessons to children in Brooklyn) and Boys & Girls Clubs of New Jersey. Cruikshank and Mozer co-produced last year's CitySkate benefit, which raised over \$15,000 for Brooklyn Ice and they're hoping that this year's show is equally successful.
